



How the program works:

Children, depending on their grade level, need to read, or be read to, a set number of books. After each book has been read, the title and author of each book needs to be written down in their reading log located inside their folder. We ask that each child checks in with their reading log each week to get their sheet stamped and gets a turn to spin our wheel for a prize.

Every child who returns their reading log will receive a book bag at the end of the program even if they do not attend or participate in every event listed inside the folder. Children who check in each week and get the corresponding stamp will receive a book and bag at the end of the program and will be entered into the raffle for our grand prizes.

Children birth through 2nd grade are asked to read, or be read to, 30 picture books of their choice or they can read 5 chapter books. (6 picture books equals 1 chapter book.)

Children 3rd through 5th grade are asked to read 5 chapter books of their choice.

We ask you to return your reading log to us only on the days and times indicated on the *Calendar of Events* page inside your booklet.

You may return your reading log early only if you will be out of town. A prize will be given to you upon your return. Those who are able to return their reading log on time will be given a chance to receive additional prizes on the last two days of the program only.

Library policy directs that all children under the age of nine (9) be directly supervised at all library activities by a parent, legal guardian, or sibling at least 16 years old. We will gladly show you the policy if you wish.



Instrucciones para el programa:

Niños, conforme a su grado y nivel, necesitan leer o que les sea leído cierto número de libros.

Niños desde recién nacidos hasta segundo grado se les requiere que lean o que se les sea leído 30 libros de ilustraciones de su preferencia o 5 libros de capítulos. (6 libros de ilustraciones es igual que un libro de capítulos.)

Niños de tercero a quinto grado necesitan leer cinco (5) libros de capítulos de su preferencia.

Después de que cada libro ha sido leído, el título y el autor de cada libro se anotará en su lista de lectura que se localiza dentro del cuaderno de registro.

Cuando se completa la lista se les pide que la regresen cualquiera de los últimos tres días del programa. Habrá un premio sorpresa y actividades adicionales para los niños que regresan su lista a tiempo. Revise el *Calendario de Eventos* para las fechas y horarios.

Pueden regresar su registro de lectura temprano solamente si no va a estar disponible en cualquiera de los dos últimos días del programa. Recibirán solamente una bolsa para libros a su regreso.

Nota: No es necesario que asista o participe en cada programa anotado en el calendario de eventos. Solamente se necesita leer la cantidad de libros que son requeridos para terminar el programa satisfactoriamente.

Beaver Search: Each Wednesday the library's READER BEAVER will be hiding somewhere around the town. Oregon Rocks: Dig deep into rocks, fossils, earthquakes and volcanos with fun, hands-on activities and rockin' specimens, discovering the forces that have shaped Oregon's landscape over time.

Scavenger Hunt: Look high, look low, see what you can find hidden in the library. To participate in this activity drop into the library between 1 p.m. and 3 p.m., we estimate it should take about 20 minutes to complete the hunt.

Can You Guess the Sound: Shake the jars and see if you can guess what items are responsible for the noise you hear. This activity is a drop in and is estimated to take about 20 minutes.

Music lab: Want to be a musician but don't have an instrument? In this activity we'll be making some fun instruments out of recycled materials. All materials will be provided.

Party!: Celebrate your completion of the Summer Reading Program with us and enjoy some cake and ice cream!
