



How the Program Works:

Teens, **sign the Summer Reading Program registration form.** Included is your pledge to read during the summer. Choose the number of pages or books you feel you can successfully read during the 6 week program.

You are **NOT** required to attend or participate in every program listed on the calendar to successfully complete the Summer Reading Program. But you must attend or complete **a minimum of 8 activities of your choice.** Remember to sign in **EACH** time you attend a program.

We have added an extra incentive to attend programs this year. Each time you go to a program you will receive a ticket to enter into a drawing for a **SURPRISE REWARD** given during the last week of the program.

Activity Breakdown

BINGO In your packet you will find a Bingo card with **different types of books to read and physical events to complete**. You must read and complete a horizontal, vertical, or diagonal Bingo. Once complete turn in your sheet at the library to be eligible for a prize drawing. Your Bingo card **and** favorite book form must be **turned during the week of July 16**.

FAVORITE 2018 Song/Musician Give us the title and a couple of sentences why you liked this song/musician so much. Form must be **turned in during the week of July 16**.

SUMMER OF SCALES: Animal expert and television personality Corbin Maxey will be here with some of his scaly friends and exotic animals.

GET BOOKED There are 2 sessions of the Get Booked book club this year. Each session is **limited to the first 10 registrants**. There are 2 different titles to choose from.
