PUMPKIN DECORATING

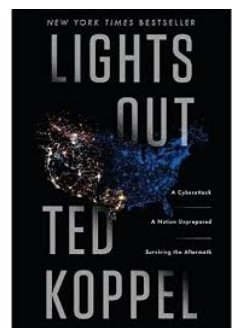

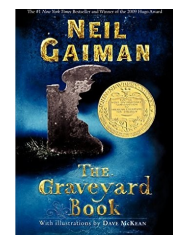
& HALLOWEEN PARTY:
